AOC Pessac-Léognan, Bordeaux, France

The vineyard was created in the 17th century on a deep gravelly hillside, well drained and remarkably well exposed. In 2004, the new owners decided to focus on top-of-the-range quality. In the commune of Martillac, in the heart of the Pessac-Léognan appellation.

The winery is a real jewel of technology, part of an eco-responsible movement to produce quality, delicious wines.

TERROIR

Gravel soils and subsoils.

IN THE VINEYARD

The vines benefit from excellent water regulation which, combined with the natural poverty of the soils, produces perfectly ripe, concentrated grapes.

WINEMAKING

Hand picking & sorted.

AGEING

Aged for 12 to 15 months in barrels (25% new, 50% one-wine barrels, 25% two-wine barrels).

VARIETALS

Cabernet sauvignon 70%, Merlot 30%

Contains sulphites.

AGEING POTENTIAL

10 to 15 years

TASTING

Powerful and complex wine.

VISUAL APPEARANCE

Deep red color.

AT NOSE

Complex bouquet of black fruits, raspberries and blackberries, spices and menthol.

ON THE PALATE

Elegant and concentrated palate, same aromas as in the nose. In the finish ample and fine tannins which allow excellent aging
