## Château Barrail de Brisson 2022

AOP Saint-Emilion grand cru, Bordeaux, France

Small family-owned vineyard located in Vignonet, to the South of the Saint-Emilion Appellation and recently converted to organic farming. Château Barrail de Brisson presents its first organic vintage (2014), showing typical Saint-Emilion Grand Cru appellation's characteristics.

### TERROIR

Sandy and silty soils

### IN THE VINEYARD

Harvested by hand

### HARVEST

08/09/2022

### WINEMAKING

Gravity flow winemaking with temperature control  
Pre-fermenting maceration  
From 25 to 30 days maceration

### AGEING

Aged in French oak barrels (20 to 40% new oak barrels) from 12 to 14 months

### VARIETAL

Merlot 100%

### TECHNICAL DATA

Surface area of the vineyard: 2.76 ha

Contains sulphites.

### SERVING

Serve at room temperature.

### VISUAL APPEARANCE

A wine with a lovely bright colour with dark purple hints.

### AT NOSE

A pleasant nose of stone red fruits (cherry, plum) which after breathing evolves towards wilder and more spicy aromas.

### ON THE PALATE

Powerful palate with great complexity, elegance and roundness. Lingering finish, a typical nice wine of Saint-Emilion !
