VISUAL APPEARANCE

A wine with a lovely bright colour with dark purple hints.

A pleasant nose of stone red fruits (cherry, plum) which after breathing evolves towards wilder and more spicy aromas.

Powerful palate with great complexity, elegance and roundness. Lingering finish, a typical nice wine of Saint-Emilion!

This is the perfect partner with lamb chops cooked in rosemary.
