AOC Pessac-Léognan, Bordeaux, France

The vineyard was created in the 17th century on a deep gravelly hillside, well drained and remarkably well exposed. In 2004, the new owners decided to focus on top-of-the-range quality. In the commune of Martillac, in the heart of the Pessac-Léognan appellation.

The winery is a real jewel of technology, part of an eco-responsible movement.

TERROIR

Sols argilo-calcaires

WINEMAKING

Cold pressing and settling. Alcoholic fermentation in barrels with stirring.

AGEING

Aged for 10 months in French oak barrels.

VARIETALS

Sémillon 48%, Sauvignon blanc 45%,
Sauvignon gris 5%, Muscadelle 2%

Contains sulphites.

AGEING POTENTIAL

5 to 10 years

TASTING

Belle fraîcheur en attaque, arômes intenses de bourgeon de cassis, de buis, d'agrumes et de fruits exotiques. Beaucoup de rondeur, très belle longueur en bouche.
