This wine boasts a deep ruby hue with captivating purplish highlights that invite you to take a sip. Its nose reveals a harmonious bouquet of fresh, ripe fruit, subtly complemented by notes of toasted almonds and vanilla. The palate shows remarkable complexity with silky tannins, a broad, velvety texture and excellent length.
