



Château du Gazin 2020

AOC Canon Fronsac, Bordeaux, France

The domain of Château du Gazin is located in the northeast of Bordeaux, just 5 km from Libourne, very close to the Saint Emilion and Pomerol appellations. It clings to the slopes of a beautiful valley that cuts through the Fronsadais plateau.

PRESENTATION

Family property for several generations.
2nd year of conversion to organic farming (ECOCERT).

TERROIR

Clay-limestone soils on asteriated limestone beds.

IN THE VINEYARD

Grassed or worked vines, no chemical weeding.
Traditional pruning. Single Guyot, de-budding, leaf thinning, green harvesting.

WINEMAKING

Sulphite-free vinification, sulphiting at bottling, total destemming, sorting.
Traditional vinification in concrete tanks with temperature control.
Maceration for 22 days.

AGEING

Traditional ageing for 18 months in tanks and barrels.

VARIETALS

Merlot 85%, Cabernet franc 10%, Malbec 5%

TECHNICAL DATA

Surface area of the vineyard: 30 ha

Contains sulphites.

VISUAL APPEARANCE

Ruby red colour with purple reflections.

AT NOSE

The nose is powerful with aromas of strawberry and blackcurrant, enhanced by a touch of slightly caramelized and cocoa nutmeg.

ON THE PALATE

The palate is full-bodied, with silky and fresh tannins. The flavours of Burlat cherry, strawberry Charlotte are prolonged on notes of sweet pepper and mocha.

FOOD PAIRINGS

This wine will be the perfect partner for a duck breast or roast chicken, accompanied by a ratatouille.
