AOP Saint-Emilion, Bordeaux, France

This estate, member of Union de Producteurs since 1955, is located to the South East of Saint-Emilion, in the village of Saint Hippolyte. The name of the château comes from the place where most plots of vineyard can be found. Château Rastouillet Lescure is definitely one of the "sleepers" in its own category which deserves to be better known!

WINEMAKING

Filling-in stainless steel or concrete vats with temperature control Pre-fermenting maceration From 20 to 30 days maceration Malolactic fermentation in vats

Aged in vats from 12 to 14 months

Merlot 75%, Cabernets 25%

Contains sulphites.

Surface area of the vineyard: 7.84 ha

Serve at room temperature.

There is obvious red fruit which is pure and concentrated. It is elegant and refined with very typical Saint-Emilion characteristics.

Enjoy with beef casserole with thyme dumplings, roast leg of lamb or a plate of fine mature cheeses.
