Aged in French oak barrels (20 to 40% new oak barrels) from 12 to 14 months

Merlot 65%, Cabernets 35%

TECHNICAL DATA Surface area of the vineyard: 4.84 ha

Contains sulphites.

Serve at room temperature.

ON THE PALATE

This has lovely, soft Merlot fruit with ripe tannins and red berry fruit flavours on the palate. It sees oak-ageing, thereby retaining all it's fresh fruit character.

This is a perfect partner for red meat, especially roast leg of lamb, although it makes a good match for roast poultry or moderately mature cheese.
