IN THE VINEYARD

Harvested by plots and grape varieties selections

HARVEST

08/09/2022

WINEMAKING

Gravity flow winemaking with temperature control

Pre-fermenting maceration

From 25 to 30 days maceration

AGEING

Aged in French oak barrels (20 to 40% new oak barrels) from 12 to 14 months

VARIETALS

Merlot 85%, Cabernet franc 15%

TECHNICAL DATA

Surface area of the vineyard: 6.86 ha

Contains sulphites.

SERVING

Serve at room temperature.

VISUAL APPEARANCE

A garnet-colored robe

AT NOSE

with nice and generous aromas (red berries, toasted and vanilla hints)

ON THE PALATE

On the palate, the wine is appealing, soft and well-balanced. It is round with good backbone and lingering finish.
