



Loudenne Le Château White 2022

Like the greatest Médoc wines, Château LOUDENNE's vineyard benefits from an exceptional terroir located on the edge of the Gironde estuary which, like a mirror, reflects the sun's rays, reduces the risk of frost and promotes the ripening of the grapes. This privileged location gives the wines of LOUDENNE elegance, complexity and finesse.

PRESENTATION

In 1880, Loudenne is the first Château of the Medoc region to produce white wine. Since then, Loudenne crafts a dry Bordeaux white, both lively and well-balanced.

TERROIR

clay-limestone or clay-gravel on a limestone sub-soil.

IN THE VINEYARD

Plot selection.

HARVEST

Hand picking in small crates early in the morning to benefit from the coolness of the night. Sorting table on reception.

The whole bunches are pressed at cold temperature with a long pressing cycle.

WINEMAKING

80% in French oak barrels originated from Bordeaux coopers. 1/3 new oak.

20% in vats to express and preserve the Sauvignon flavors.

No malolactic fermentation.

VARIETALS

Sauvignon 77%, Sémillon 23%

Contains sulphites.

TECHNICAL DATA

Surface area of the vineyard: 6.6 ha

Age of vines: 15 years old

AGEING POTENTIAL

3 to 5 years

VISUAL APPEARANCE

Beautiful pale golden yellow color.

AT NOSE

Very expressive nose of exotic fruit (pineapple) and citrus fruits (lemon, grapefruit).

ON THE PALATE

The wine presents a powerful explosion of fruit flavours as well as floral notes. The final features a beautiful length, with salty notes, characteristics of Loudenne's white wine.
