TFRROIR

Clay-limestone soils

IN THE VINEYARD

Planted over 35 years ago on a 2-hectare plot, Château de Stella aims to be intimate to give special attention to its vines and clusters. Leaf removal, shoot thinning, cluster selection, soil aeration, daily work between the rows of the vineyard.

WINEMAKING

Vinification in temperature-controlled stainless steel vats.

AGFING

Aging in French oak barrels for 12 to 15 months.

VARIETALS

Merlot 70%, Cabernet franc 30%

14 % VOL.

Contains sulphites.

TECHNICAL DATA

Production volume: 8200 Surface area of the vineyard: 2 ha

TASTING

Light scents of sweet spices, pepper, and licorice, along with delicious hints of vanilla, reveal its time spent in oak barrels.

VISUAL APPEARANCE

A bright red dress with beautiful bluish hues.

AT NOSE

An expressive nose enhanced by merlot, with scents of red fruits, redcurrants, and raspberries.

ON THE PALATE

In the mouth a frank attack with velvety but delicate tannins giving way to a beautiful aromatic persistence for a balanced and fresh wine.
