



# Château De Béchaud 2022

AOP Saint-Emilion grand cru, Bordeaux, France

Ideally located at the bottom of the slope of the village of Saint-Emilion, this mediumsized property is one of the sleepers of the Appellation. Harvest is done by hand, low yield and meticulous sorting of the grapes result in a sumptuous blend of 65% Merlot and 35% Cabernets.

Merlot 65%, C. Franc 20%, C. Sauvignon 15%

Serve at room temperature.

# AT NOSE

Dominated by notes of soft and mature fruit.

This Saint-Emilion is round and juicy and even shows an attractive spicy character.
