



Château Mancèdre White 2022

AOC Pessac-Léognan, Bordeaux, France

The vineyard was created in the 17th century on a deep gravelly hillside, well drained and remarkably well exposed. In 2004, the new owners decided to focus on top-of-the-range quality. In the commune of Martillac, in the heart of the Pessac-Léognan appellation.

In 2009, the adventure continues with 1.70 ha planted with white grape varieties. The winery is a real jewel of technology, part of an eco-responsible movement to produce quality, delicious wines.

The vines benefit from excellent water regulation which, combined with the natural poverty of the soil, is favourable to obtaining perfectly ripe and concentrated grapes

Manuelle, triée
