TERROIR

Old sands and clay-limestone soils

IN THE VINEYARD

Harvested by plots and grape varieties selections

WINEMAKING

Gravity flow winemaking with temperature control

Pre-fermenting maceration

From 25 to 30 days maceration

AGEING

Aged in French oak barrels from 12 to 14 months

VARIETALS

Merlot 82%, Cabernet franc 18%

Contains sulphites.

SERVING

Serve at room temperature.

TASTING

A luscious wine with wonderful length.

AT NOSE

This wine reveals a nice complex nose of red fruits aromas and wooden notes.

ON THE PALATE

In the mouth, good tannic structure, roundness and silky smoothness; ripe fruits aromas subtly associated with delicate oaky flavours.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Pair with roasted or braised meats and strong, semi-mature cheeses.
