AOP Saint-Emilion grand cru, Bordeaux, France

Situated on the northern slopes of Saint-Emilion, Château Le Loup is generally recognised as one of the appellation's references. The unusual blend composed of 50% Merlot and 50% Cabernets offers a Medoc-type wine.

### TERROIR

Clay-limestone soils

### IN THE VINEYARD

Harvested half by hand

### HARVEST

08/09/2022

### WINEMAKING

Gravity flow winemaking with temperature control  
Pre-fermenting maceration  
From 25 to 30 days maceration

### AGEING

Aged in French oak barrels (20 to 40% new oak barrels) from 12 to 14 months

### VARIETALS

Cabernet franc 50%, Merlot 50%

### TECHNICAL DATA

Surface area of the vineyard: 6.38 ha

Contains sulphites.

### SERVING

Serve at room temperature.

### ON THE PALATE

This is a lovely open wine with a fleshy fruit, elegant tannins and good concentration. The fruit lingers well through the length.

### FOOD PAIRINGS

This balanced red would make an ideal partner for quality red meats like seared fillet steak, rack of lamb or a herb-crusted roast loin of pork.
