The property benefits from the influences of the Atlantic Ocean on the one hand, and the presence of the Gironde estuary on the other, offering favourable weather conditions for the development of the grape varieties and the ripeness of the grapes. The vineyard grows on gravel worthy of the best terroirs of the Médoc. Today, the Château estate is made up of 90 hectares of AOC Médoc grouped around the estate, of which 53 hectares are planted with vines that currently produce wine.

Mechanical and manual work depending on the plots.

AGFING

12 months in barrels (33% new barrels).

VARIETALS

Merlot 50%, Cabernet sauvignon 45%, Petit verdot 5%

AGEING POTENTIAL

10 to 15 years

TASTING

Sleek, long structure that gives extra sharpness and character. This distinguished wine is also very generous and graceful. This is a vintage that will age well.

VISUAL APPEARANCE

Intense red.

AT NOSE

A complex blend of cherries, raspberries, subtle spices' blends into aromas of toasted brioche and scents coming from cedar.

ON THE PALATE

Volume and roundness.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Grilled rack of lamb, red meat, porcini mushrooms with parsley, grilled duck breast and strong cheeses.
