



Château Roche Lalande La Croix 2018

AOC Pessac-Léognan, Bordeaux, France

The vineyard was created in the 17th century on a deep gravelly hillside, well drained and remarkably well exposed. In 2004, the new owners decided to focus on top-of-the-range quality. In the commune of Martillac, in the heart of the Pessac-Léognan appellation.

The winery is a real jewel of technology, part of an eco-responsible movement to produce quality, delicious wines.

TERROIR

A bit of grit on clay-limestone

WINFMAKING

Cold skin maceration to extract the varietal aromas from the grapes. Alcoholic fermentation in stainless steel vats Malolactic fermentation in barrels 12 months, 50% in French oak barrels

VARIETALS

Merlot 48%, Cabernet sauvignon 45%, Cabernet franc 5%. Petit verdot 2% Contains sulphites.

AGEING POTENTIAL

5 to 10 years

TASTING

A very elegant, refined wine with very typical Pessac Léognan characteristics. A garnet-red colour. A nose combining vanilla, fruit and roasting. The attack is straightforward, and the palate is not to be outdone: supported by velvety tannins, nuances of red and roasted fruit, before a lovely, long finish.
