The vineyards amount to 6 ha all told and are located on the sandy plateau of the appellation. Overall, the mix of grape varieties is unusual for Saint-Emilion, Merlot and Cabernet Franc. Yields are controlled strictly with grass implanting one row out of two. A good wine in its own right!

Filling-in stainless steel or concrete vats with temperature control Pre-fermenting maceration From 20 to 30 days maceration Malolactic fermentation in vats

AGEING

Aged in vats from 12 to 14 months

VARIETALS

Merlot 45%, Cabernet franc 40%, Cabernet sauvignon 15%

Contains sulphites.

TECHNICAL DATA

Surface area of the vineyard: 6.71 ha

SERVING

Serve at room temperature.

An elegant well-structured wine with delicious strawberry character on the nose and palate with a lovely lingering aftertaste.
