AOP Saint-Emilion grand cru, Bordeaux, France

Gravity flow winemaking with temperature control Pre-fermenting maceration From 25 to 30 days maceration

AGFINI

Aged in French oak barrels (20 to 40% new oak barrels) from 12 to 14 months

VARIETAI

Merlot 100%

Surface area of the vineyard: 5.09 ha

Contains sulphites.

SERVING

Serve at room temperature.

VISUAL APPEARANCE

Nice deep bright purple-red colour with brick-red glints.

AT NOSE

On the nose, there are jammy fruits aromas with toasted hints.

ON THE PALATE

The fruits and tannins are balanced and well-structured. It has typical Saint-Emilion prettiness, freshness and elegance with juicy red fruits.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Savour this fine wine with grilled lamb cutlets or filet steak with a peppercorn sauce.
