Filling-in stainless steel or concrete vats with temperature control Pre-fermenting maceration From 20 to 30 days maceration Malolactic fermentation in vats

Merlot 85%, Cabernets 15%

Surface area of the vineyard: 1.94 ha

Contains sulphites.

Serve at room temperature.
