TERROIR

Clayey-sandy soils

Harvested by plots and grape varieties selections

HARVEST

08/09/2022

WINEMAKING

Gravity flow winemaking with temperature control

Pre-fermenting maceration

From 25 to 30 days maceration

AGEING

Aged in French oak barrels (20 to 40% new oak barrels) from 12 to 14 months

VARIETALS

Merlot 85%, Cabernet franc 15%

TECHNICAL DATA

Surface area of the vineyard: 4.24 ha

Contains sulphites.

SERVING

Serve at room temperature.

TASTING

This has a delicious supple red fruit character of plums, black currents and cherries backed up by good structure and ripe tannins. It will age well.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Serve at room temperature to partner such classic dishes as grilled duck magret or lamb.
