TERROIR

Gravelly and clay-limestone soils

IN THE VINEYARD

Most of the grapes are harvested by hand.
Double sorting of grapes before and after destemming on a table.

WINEMAKING

Traditional vinification.

AGEING

Aged in oak barrels for 14 months.

VARIETALS

Merlot 58%, Cabernet sauvignon 30%, Cabernet franc 10%, Petit verdot 2%

AGEING POTENTIAL

5 to 10 years, 10 to 15 years

TASTING

Elegant, subtle and sensual, but also distinctive and uncompromising, this wine invites you on an exciting aromatic journey! A ruby colour with garnet highlights, typicality and minerality, generosity and depth of tannins. A very subtle balance of grape varieties, surprised by unique aromas. Elegant length.
