WINEMAKING

Gravity flow winemaking with temperature control Pre-fermenting maceration From 25 to 30 days maceration

AGFINI

Aged in French oak barrels (20 to 40% new oak barrels) from 12 to 14 months

VARIETAL

Merlot 100%

TECHNICAL DATA

Surface area of the vineyard: 4.87 ha

Contains sulphites.

SERVING

Serve at room temperature.

AT NOSI

Plenty of spice and exotic fruit on the nose, set against a background of brambly, blackberry fruit.

ON THE PALATI

A soft and creamy entry with a rather more drawn out structure through the mi-palate. This has a lot of appeal.

FOOD PAIRINGS

This delightfully aromatic, elegantly wine makes a superb match for a slow-roast leg of lamb with a rosemary and anchovy crust.
