AOC Médoc, Bordeaux, France

Château Pey de Pont is a wine estate that has existed since the 1850s (listed in the 1st edition of Bordeaux and its wines) and has belonged to 3 families. It has been classified as a Cru Bourgeois since 1932.

TERROIR

Clay-limestone and sandy-gravel soils

WINEMAKING

Mechanical harvesting with sorting of the entire crop in the cellar.
Traditional vinification in temperature-controlled vats.
Vatting period of 4 to 5 weeks.

AGEING

Aged for 12 months in barrels and vats.

VARIETALS

Merlot 54%, Cabernet sauvignon 35%, Petit verdot 7%, Cabernet franc 4%

AGEING POTENTIAL

5 to 10 years

TASTING

A brilliant purple-red colour. The nose is very expressive and complex, with notes of cocoa, sweet spices and ripe black fruit. Full-bodied and fleshy on the palate, with silky tannins and a very long, aromatic finish.
