WINEMAKING Filling-in stainless steel or concrete vats with temperature control Pre-fermenting maceration

From 20 to 30 days maceration Malolactic fermentation in vats

Aged in vats from 12 to 14 months

Merlot 65%, Cabernet franc 35%

TECHNICAL DATA Surface area of the vineyard: 5.20 ha

Contains sulphites.

Serve at room temperature.

A soft, young wine with savoury, fresh fruit and medium length. Elegant tannins making for early drinking.
