AOC Canon Fronsac, Bordeaux, France

Château Mazeris is located 40 km north-east of Bordeaux, in the heart of the AOC Canon-Fronsac, neighbouring the AOC of Saint-Emilion and Pomerol, on the famous limestone plateau that has made the reputation of the great wines of the Libourne. A family business for 10 generations, the cru was already featured in the first edition of the Cocks & Féret Guide 1849.

TERROIR

Limestone tray.

WINEMAKING

Traditional in concrete tanks.
3 to 4 weeks of maceration.

AGEING

16 months in concrete vats and barrels.

VARIETALS

Merlot 80%, Cabernet franc 20%

AGEING POTENTIAL

10 to 15 years

VISUAL APPEARANCE

The color is an intense and deep ruby red with some purple reflections.

AT NOSE

Aromas of fresh red fruits and hints of vanilla, pepper and licorice.

ON THE PALATE

A superb structure, rich and fleshy. The finish is balanced and intense with a lot of freshness and length.
