Château Grand Bouquey is a family-owned estate, bought in 1956 by Mr Joseph Roblès (grandfather of the current owner); it has been member of the Union de Producteurs de Saint Emilion since 1957. Today, the vineyard is managed by Bernard Roblès (grandson), who is a member of the wine-coop and one member of the Board of Directors .

The name of the château comes from the name of the place where the estate is located., close to the medieval village of Saint Emilion.

Merlot 85%, Cabernet franc 15%

TECHNICAL DATA Surface area of the vineyard: 8.07 ha

Contains sulphites.

Serve at room temperature.

A good, well-balanced Claret, showing a plumy nose and a palate filled with excellent juicy fruit.
