Château Grand Bouquey is a family-owned estate, bought in 1956 by Mr Joseph Roblès (grandfather of the current owner); it has been member of the Union de Producteurs de Saint Emilion since 1957. Today, the vineyard is managed by Bernard Roblès (grandson), who is a member of the wine-coop and one member of the Board of Directors .

The name of the château comes from the name of the place where the estate is located., close to the medieval village of Saint Emilion.

Old sands and clayey-sandy soils

Harvested by plots and grape varieties selections

HARVEST

23/09/2021

WINEMAKING

Filling-in stainless steel or concrete vats with temperature control

Pre-fermenting maceration

From 20 to 30 days maceration

Malolactic fermentation in vats

AGEING

Aged in vats from 12 to 14 months

VARIETALS

Merlot 85%, Cabernet franc 15%

TECHNICAL DATA

Surface area of the vineyard: 8.07 ha

Contains sulphites.

SERVING

Serve at room temperature.

TASTING

A good, well-balanced Claret, showing a plummy nose and a palate filled with excellent juicy fruit.
