Like the greatest Médoc wines, Château LOUDENNE's vineyard benefits from an exceptional terroir located on the edge of the Gironde estuary which, like a mirror, reflects the sun's rays, reduces the risk of frost and promotes the ripening of the grapes.

PRESENTATION

It is the little brother of the Château. Often defined as a second wine, it is more than that. The wines benefit from the same care as the wines of the château.

clay-limestone or clay-gravel on a limestone sub-soil.

Hand picking in small crates early in the morning to benefit from the coolness of the night. Sorting table on reception. Pressed at cold temperature.

in Bordeaux French oak barrels and in vats to express and preserve the Sauvignon flavours.

Contains sulphites.

3 to 5 years, 5 to 10 years

Loudenne produces a dry white Bordeaux, both lively and balanced.
